Make the Call

Due to Covid-19 there will be limited places to ensure strict physical distancing is met and to comply with WA Health directions.

Intention: to provide essential knowledge and skills in reporting and responding to all forms of child abuse and neglect, including mandatory reporting of child sexual abuse.

Target audience: Mandatory Reporters of child sexual abuse; doctors, teachers, midwives, police officers, boarding supervisors from Government and non-government organisations must be over the age of (18+) to attend.

Learning Outcomes - increase knowledge of:

- relevant legislation and reporting pathways
- best practice in child abuse report-writing and record-keeping
- best practice response to children's problematic and harmful sexual behaviour
- the National Child Safe Principles
